



Delicia Circuit (medium)

10.5km. Allow 5 hours. This is a circuit and your vehicle can be left at **4M** entry point.

This walk takes in the Linda Garrett Circuit, the Ubajee Walkers Camp and Gheerulla Falls. The Ubajee Walkers Camp lookout is the perfect spot for a picnic. After crossing Gheerulla Creek take the short detour to the picturesque falls. Exit the forest onto Delicia Road **8** and follow the road 2.7km. returning to your vehicle or pick-up point at **4M**. Use caution as there is no footpath.

WARNING! Walk only in daylight. Start your walk with plenty of time to finish. Plan to finish your walk well before sunset. Do not rely on your mobile phone as phone coverage is unreliable. Sections of The Great Walk are remote and isolated. ALWAYS tell a responsible person where you are going and when you expect to return.

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Thilba Thalba Walkers Camp to Delicia Road Circuit (Medium)

14km. Allow 7 hours. Drop off at **7** and finish the walk at **8**. A long and varied full day walk for the reasonably fit. Ensure you start the walk early to finish in daylight. Entry point is at **7** and proceed to the Thilba Thalba Walkers Camp and on through open scrubby gum forest to Gheerulla Bluff taking in views of the Mary Valley.

Descend to the Gheerulla Creek Recreation Area. Follow the creek with its many crossings and (W=wet feet, D=dry feet) delightful picnic spots using old logging trails of days gone by. Take a detour to Gheerulla Falls to cool off under the cascade. Exit the forest onto Delicia Road at **8**.



You can choose to add another 7.7km to your walk (3 hours) through the dense rainforest that runs parallel to Delicia Road that joins **8** to **7**.

Leafy Lane Trail Head provides access for short walk to Ubajee walkers camp, Lookout and Gheerulla Falls.

NOTE: Entry points **4M**, **8** & **7** along Delicia Road are not always easy to find. We suggest you zero your trip meter at the start of Delicia road in Mapleton and then use these distances to assist in the location of the entry points.

The start of Delicia Road to entry point **4M** = 1.9km. The start of Delicia Road to where the path crosses Delicia Road coming from Mapleton Falls and finishing at entry point **4M** = 2.4km.

The start of Delicia Road to entry point **8** = 4.4km. The start of Delicia Road to entry point **7** = 8.6km.

Flaxton to Mapleton Falls (Medium)

7.3 km. Allow 5 hours. This is a one way walk and you will need to arrange drop-off or pick-up. Start at **2A** Flaxton Mill Road and finish at **3M** Mapleton Falls car park and picnic area.

This is a moderate walk for the reasonably fit taking in open Eucalypt forests, rocky outcrops and Baxter Creek with a beautiful waterfall. Cross the creek by the suspension bridge and walk through a tranquil palm filled grove.

The descent to Baxter Creek is steep as is the climb out to the Mapleton Falls carpark and picnic area. There is a wonderful viewing platform just off the carpark with magnificent views of the falls, the rainforest below and the valley beyond.

Lake Baroon to Kondalilla Falls (Hard) OR Kondalilla Falls to Lake Baroon (Medium)

11.7 km. Allow 5 hours. These are one way walks and you will need to arrange drop-off or pick-up. Kondalilla Falls to Lake Baroon is an easier walk with only a short climb to the Baroon Lookout. Start at **2M** the Kondalilla Falls carpark and walk to **1M** the Lake Baroon car park.

Cross bridges over palm and vine forested streams. See spectacular views of the Gorge, Lake Baroon and Obi Obi creek. Boardwalks protect the rare frog habitats. Enjoy the giant Strangler Figs in lush rainforest and take a refreshing dip in the Kondalilla Falls natural rockpool.

Lake Baroon to the Baroon Lookout To the Lookout and back, an easy walk.

4.4 km. Time allow 2 hours return. Start at **1M** at Lake Baroon. The walk entry is at the end of the carpark. An enchanting short walk, featuring boardwalks, bridges and, after rain, waterfalls. The Baroon Lookout has beautiful views of the lake and the Obi Obi gorge. Along the way a spur track of 225m leads down to the Narrows Lookout. The climb back up to the main track is steep.
